Colossians 4:2-6 - Devote yourselves to prayer, keeping alert in it with an attitude of thanksgiving; ³ praying at the same time for us as well, that God will open up to us a door for the word, so that we may proclaim the mystery of Christ, for which I have also been imprisoned; ⁴ that I may make it clear in the way that I ought to proclaim it. ⁵Conduct yourselves with wisdom toward outsiders, making the most of the opportunity. ⁶ Your speech must always be with grace, as though seasoned with salt, so that you will know how you should respond to each person.

- Proclaim the gospel

- 13. How does proclaiming Christ help us to put Jesus over everything?
- 14. Can we put Jesus over everything and no proclaim him?
