- 6. Why do you think that a Christian would find themselves feeling like something was missing in life?

John 10:10 - The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full.

- 7. What do you think the difference in this verse is between 'life' and 'life to the full'?
- 8. Pastor Bill said that he interpreted 'life' to mean salvation and eternity with God in heaven, and 'life to the full' to mean experiencing all that God has for you now and in the future. What are your thoughts about this?

Matthew 19:16 - ¹⁶ Just then a man came up to Jesus and asked, "Teacher, what good thing must I do to get eternal life?" ¹⁷ "Why do you ask me about what is good?" Jesus replied. "There is only One who is good. If you want to enter life, keep the commandments." ¹⁸ "Which ones?" he inquired. Jesus replied, "You shall not murder, you shall not commit adultery, you shall not steal, you shall not give false testimony, ¹⁹ honor your father and mother', and 'love your neighbor as yourself.'" ²⁰ "All these I have kept," the young man said. "What do I still lack?" ²¹ Jesus answered, "If you want to be perfect, go, sell your possessions and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven. Then come, follow me." ²² When the young man heard this, he went away sad, because he had great wealth.

- 13. Why do you think that Jesus chose the commands that he asked the rich man about and not some of the other commands?
- 14. Pastor Bill said that it seemed like the rich ruler had a blind spot to the hold that money had on him, and clearly he wouldn't give up his money to follow Jesus. How do we know if we have any blind spots to what has a hold on us?
- 15. Who in your life can help you see your blind spots?
