1. What would you say is one of the most important things that Jesus asks his followers to do?
2. How do we know if we will hear, “Well done”, when we get to heaven?

Matthew 28:16-20 - Then the eleven disciples left for Galilee, going to the mountain where Jesus had told them to go. ¹⁷ When they saw him, they worshiped him—but some of them doubted! ¹⁸ Jesus came and told his disciples, “I have been given all authority in heaven and on earth. ¹⁹ Therefore, go and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. ²⁰ Teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you. And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age.”

3. If you were one of Jesus’ disciples in the above verses, how would you have responded to Jesus’ request?
4. Do you think there is any significance to where and when Jesus spoke these words?
 - a. Where – Most likely the same place as the Sermon on the Mount (Matthew 5-7).
 - b. When – around 3 weeks after Jesus’ resurrection.
5. As a follower of Jesus, do you feel that Jesus is saying these words to you. Why or why not?
6. Why do you think that Jesus asks his followers to help others follow Him?
7. What is the significance that Jesus was given all authority in heaven and on earth?
8. What promise does he give his disciples as they go and make disciples?
9. If you were going to help others follow Jesus, where would you do that?
10. What do you think it looks like today to help others follow Jesus?
11. How could you make the challenge to make disciples a part of your daily life?
12. Who are those people who live near you? Do you know them? Do you know what’s going on in their lives?
13. How could you show love to your neighbors?
14. Who else do you rub shoulders with? Family, Coworkers, Friends? How could you show God’s love to them?
15. Who are you praying for? Who can you pray for?
