2 Takeaways

1. There is value and honor given to serving and those who serve.  
\* Don't miss this: I can hear "well done" from Jesus
2. Both men and women were leading/in leadership in the church!

Conviction: I will not add to, nor will I take away from the scripture.

*All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness.*

*2 Timothy 3:16*

The first and primary rule for understanding is context

1 Timothy 2:1-7 – Wholehearted worship and with heart toward evangelism

1 Timothy 2:8 – Men without anger or argumentativeness

1 Timothy 2:9-10 – Women without immodesty or flaunting of wealth

*1 Timothy 2:11-12*

Gune – wife (woman)  
Aner – husband (man)

Thē lus – female/woman  
Arsēn – male/man

Grammatical shift from plural to singular

The issue – “assuming authority”

\* Authentein – the abusive use of authority (dominate another)

i.e. A wife should learn w/ quietness, practicing submission to her husband, not trying to dominant over her husband in public worship.

**Mutualism** – God’s original plan for man and women (husband and wife) – “equal and different”

Jesus’ plan – “mutual submission” vs “authentein”

*Submit to one another out of reverence for Christ.*

*Ephesians 5:21*

Standard for teaching – 2 Timothy 2:2

*You have heard me teach things that have been confirmed by many reliable witnesses. Now teach these truths to other trustworthy people who will be able to pass them on to others.*

*2 Timothy 2:2 (NLT)*

Teachers

1. They must have learned
2. They must display Christ-like character
3. Teach so others will learn and share
