TRUTH: God has already given grace to each of us.

*"Remember this: Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also reap generously.*

*Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.*

*And God is able to bless you abundantly, so that in all things at all times, having all that you need, you will abound in every good work."*

Whenever we give out of God's grace, 3 things happen:

- 1) others get the help they need
- 2) God gives us more grace
- 3) God gets glory
