- 4. What do you want to be known for?
- 5. If you asked your family, coworkers and neighbors, what would they say about who you are?

For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do. – Ephesians 2:10

- 6. What goes through your mind when you read that you are God's handiwork or masterpiece?
- 7. According to this verse why were you created? Are you living that out?
- 8. Why do you think that God created you to do good works?
- 9. What do you think it means that God prepared good works in advance for us to do?

The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full. – John 10:10 (Jesus)

- 10. Jesus came to give us life to the full. What does that mean to you? What do you think that means to Jesus?
- 11. On a scale of 1 to 10 how much do you think you are currently experiencing 'Life to the Full'?
- 12. Why do you think that sometimes we don't feel like we are experiencing 'Life to the Full'?
- 13. How do you think that 'doing good works' influences how we experience fullness in life?

Each of you should use whatever gift you have received to serve others, as faithful stewards of God's grace in its various forms. – 1 Peter 4:10

- 14. What gifts have you been given?
- 15. How are you using them to serve others?
