WHAT I *think* ABOUT GOD

What we think about God will greatly determine the relationship we have with God.

What does God think about me?

A Sinner or A Saint

Truth: *All have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.*

Romans 3:23

Truth: My sin nature still exists even when I become a Christian.

Truth: I will struggle with sin until the day I die.

If you have trusted Jesus as your savior, you are a saint.

God is not oblivious to our sin.

That God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting people's sins against them. And he has committed to us the message of reconciliation." It is not us eliminating our sin that transforms us from sinner to saint, it is Jesus.
