- 1. Have you ever been in a courtroom?
- 2. Do you think of God as judgy?
- 3. Where do you think that people get the idea that God is judgy?

John 9:1-2 - As he went along, he saw a man blind from birth. <sup>2</sup> His disciples asked him, "Rabbi, who sinned, this man or his parents, that he was born blind?"

John 9:34 - To this they replied, "You were steeped in sin at birth; how dare you lecture us!" And they threw him out.

- 4. Why do you think that we tend to think that our problems are the result of our sin?
- 5. Have you ever thought that you were facing judgement or punishment from God for things you had done?
- 6. What's the difference between consequences of sin and punishment for sin?

John 9:39 - Jesus said, "For judgment I have come into this world, so that the blind will see and those who see will become blind."

- 7. Jesus condemns the Pharisees as blind, while having mercy on the blind man and giving him sight. Whom does Jesus judge while on the earth?
- 8. Whom does Jesus show compassion and mercy towards?

Romans 2:4b - God's kindness is intended to lead you to repentance

2 Peter 3:9b - he is patient with you, not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance.

- 9. How does it make you feel to know that God is patient and kind with us?
- 10. If God doesn't judge us, why do we still suffer from bad things?
- 11. How would you describe the law of sowing and reaping?

1 John 1:8-10 - If we claim to be without sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us. <sup>9</sup> If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness. <sup>10</sup> If we claim we have not sinned, we make him out to be a liar and his word is not in us.

John 3:16-18 - For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. <sup>17</sup> For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through him. <sup>18</sup> Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe stands condemned already because they have not believed in the name of God's one and only Son.

- 13. When have you experienced God's grace and compassion when you didn't deserve it?
- 14. When have you suffered the consequences of sin?
