





# FOLLOWING JESUS' EXAMPLE

*“I have set an example for you”*

*Jesus (John 13:15)*

*Then Jesus came from Galilee to the Jordan to be baptized by John. But John tried to deter him, saying, “I need to be baptized by you, and do you come to me?”*

*Jesus replied, “Let it be so now; it is proper for us to do this to fulfill all righteousness.” Then John consented.*

*As soon as Jesus was baptized, he went up out of the water. At that moment heaven was opened, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and alighting on him. And a voice from heaven said, “This is my Son, whom I love; with him I am well pleased.”*

John the Baptizer:

- 1<sup>st</sup> prophet of God in 430 years
- Jesus said John was the fulfillment of Elijah’s prophecy

Jesus when baptized was looking forward, while we look back

Jesus Example (believer's baptism) is His universal sign/declaration for all followers of His!

Baptism Need to Knows

1. Jesus will for all believers is “Believers Baptism”

*Therefore, go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely, I am with you always, to the very end of the age.”*

*Matthew 28:19-20*

2. Baptism/Baptize means to immerse or submerge.
3. Believer's Baptism is for Believers
4. Believers Baptism is my public confession
