Think Ahead for Better tomorrows with fewer regrets

The prudent see danger and take refuge, but the simple keep going and pay the penalty.

Proverbs 22:3

*My Decisions today affect my life tomorrow.

Temptations keep coming

Sin – "My choice to do what I know God does not want me to do or my choice to not do"

So I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh. For the flesh desires what is contrary to the Spirit, and the Spirit what is contrary to the flesh. They are in conflict with each other, so that you are not to do whatever you want. But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law.

Galatians 5:16-18

Hitting The Gas

But encourage one another daily, as long as it is called "Today," so that none of you may be hardened by sin's deceitfulness.

Hebrews 3:13

The deceit of sin – it won't affect you

Sin affect: hardens ie desensitizes

Truth: Sin may be fun at times, distracting to cares and burdens; but sin is never life-giving!

Roadmap of Temptation

When tempted, no one should say, "God is tempting me." For God cannot be tempted by evil, nor does he tempt anyone; but each person is tempted when they are dragged away by their own evil desire and enticed. Then, after desire has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and sin, when it is full-grown, gives birth to death.

James 1:13-15

Think Ahead

1. Pray and ask for grace

For we do not have a high priest who is unable to empathize with our weaknesses, but we have one who has been tempted in every way, just as we are—yet he did not sin. Let us then approach God's throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need.

Hebrews 4:15-16

2. Look for and use the exit

No temptation has overtaken you except what is common to mankind. And God is faithful; he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, he will also provide a way out so that you can endure it.

1 Corinthians 10:13

3. Be quick to repent and confess

My dear children, I write this to you so that you will not sin. But if anybody does sin, we have an advocate with the Father—Jesus Christ, the Righteous One. He is the atoning sacrifice for our sins, and not only for ours but also for the sins of the whole world.

1 John 2:1-2

If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.
